BEHIND-THE-WHEEL INSTRUCTION

Behind-the-wheel lessons will be scheduled at the convenience of the student and Bay State Driving School (BSDS). Call BSDS directly at 617-393-1700 to schedule driving hours. All lessons will begin and end at Arlington High School.

Bay State Driving School & Arlington Community Education

Bay State Driving School has contracted with the Arlington Public Schools through the office of Arlington Community Education to offer Driver's Education to students wishing to obtain their Certificate of Driver Education.

Driver's Education consists of 30 hrs of classroom instruction, as well as 18 hrs of behind-the-wheel instruction. In addition, a two-hour driver safety course/orientation for a parent or guardian of the student driver will be offered, and is mandatory under state law.

All classes will be offered to any student who has reached the **minimum age of 15 years, nine months (15.9) by the beginning of the classroom lessons**. Driving lessons cannot take place without a learner's permit. Students must have it in his/her possession for all behind-the-wheel instruction. To obtain a learner's permit, students must be at least 16 years old. Please contact the Registry for more information. Submit a copy of learner's permit to Bay State Driving School as soon as you receive it. BSDS must have it on file prior to scheduling behind-the-wheel instruction. Please contact BSDS for more information.

Required Class for Parent or Guardian of Driver Education Student

For each student taking driver education, one parent (or guardian) is required to attend a 2-hour orientation to prepare for teaching their child to drive. This 2-hour class is mandated by the Registry of Motor Vehicles. At AHS, the class will be held on Thursday, July 8 from 6:00 to 8:00 pm at AHS. Please enter the Main Lobby under the white columns and follow signs.

Fees Include

Fees cover all 30 hours of classroom instruction, 18 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction (12 hrs. driving; 6 hrs. observation) and the 2-hour parent orientation. One make-up class is allowed for students who miss a class (there is no additional charge for one make-up). Fees also include Driver Education Certificate of Completion issued by the Registry of Motor Vehicles.

Fees Do Not Include

Fees do NOT include other RMV fees. Also, if a student wishes to take a road test in one of Bay State Driving School's vehicles, he or she may arrange it at additional cost with the driving school. This is an OPTIONAL service.

Furthermore, a \$40 cancellation fee will be charged to any student who has not given 24-hour notice of intention to cancel a behind-the-wheel appointment. Students must call Bay State Driving School to cancel an appointment at least 24 hours prior to the behind-the-wheel lesson. Cancelled appointments without a 24-hour notice, or "no-shows" will be charged this fee.

Why Get a Driver's Education Certificate?

Provided a student has held a learner's permit for at least 6 months, and has a clean driving record, a certificate of completion of Driver's Education will enable that student to take the road test (and if passed, obtain a driver's license) before age 18. Also, the certificate will enable a student to obtain a reduction in car insurance for several years.

Advantages to Taking Driver's Education through the Arlington Public Schools

Families are free to make other arrangements with any driving school they choose. The arrangements described in this letter have been made for the convenience of high school students in Arlington. Students will be able to complete their 30-hours classroom instruction in 4 weeks in this after school session. They will also have the convenience of being picked-up at school for Behind-the-Wheel instruction.

Dear Driver Education Students and Parents:

A FEW IMPORTANT NOTES WE'D LIKE YOU TO READ

(1) Behind-the-wheel lessons are scheduled by calling Bay State Driving School at 617-393-1700 once the student acquires a learner's permit through the Registry of Motor Vehicles. Students must have the learner's permit in their possession for each behind-the-wheel lesson. Students who arrive without the learner's permit will not be able to take the behind-the wheel lesson, and will be charged \$40 for a missed lesson.

(2) The contract form, which is part of your registration, must be signed by a parent. It certifies that you know that all cancellations of road lessons must come in at least 24-hours before the lesson. If you plan to cancel a Monday lesson, you need to call Bay State Driving School at 617-393-1700 by Friday at 5 pm before the lesson.

(3) Bay State Driving School can, at your request, take your child for his or her road test IF your child has had a learner's permit for at least six months. But the Driving School will charge extra for this service (about \$80). You may certainly take your child to the Registry on your own for the test...you do not have to use the driving school.
