Welcome to the Spring Watercolor Class! Let's paint!

If you have taken my class before, bring your supplies and supplement if needed. Perhaps add a new color or invest in better paper.

If you are new, these are the supplies I would like you to bring.

Tubes of paint. Set of twelve ( Winsor Newton cotman set/ student grade but good quality or Reeves (also available in 18, 24 tube sets) If you are willing to invest a little more money, I recommend Winsor and Newton artist grade tubes. They are sold individually.



For the primary colors, choose one cool and one warm. Here are some recommendations for cool and warm primaries and other colors as well.

2 yellows- winsor lemon and new gamboge  
2 reds - alizarin crimson permanent and winsor red  
2 blues - ultramarine and winsor blue/green shade  
1 orange - winsor orange  
1 pink - permanent rose  
1 green - winsor green yellow  
1 Burnt umber  
1 Burnt sienna  
1 Payne's gray  
Additional colors you could get: cerelean blue, violet, yellow ochre, scarlet, sap green

Three brushes - 2 rounds (#10 and 6) and 1 flat

Block of Watercolor paper - anything at least 11x14 or larger, 140 lb or 300 lb - 100% cotton. Arches is the best. very good

Palette - with many wells, mixing area and cover

Painters tape

Pencil/eraser
