## **Drawing Fundamentals. Materials list.**

(Optional materials are marked with \*)

- 1. **Pencils.** Graphite pencils of various hardness: 6B, 4B, 2B, B, HB, H, 2H. (Starting pencil set will be great). Best brands to buy are: Derwent, Faber-Castell, Caran d'Ache, Gretacolor.
- 2. **Erasers:** white block eraser, kneaded eraser.
- 3. Pencil sharpening tools.
- 4. Heavy-weight drawing paper pad (white, not cream) for finished works, approximately 11x14" or 12x16".
- 5. Vine charcoal of different hardness (in sticks).
- 6. White chalk pencil
- 7. Blending stumps, or tortillions.
- 8. Drawing board with clip.
- 9. Sketching paper any size or sketchbook.
- 10. Viewfinder (composition finder)
- 11. \* Fixative spray for charcoal drawings
- 12. \* Big soft brush to clean the drawing
- 13. \* Exacto knife or pieces of sanding paper to sharpen the pencils
- 14. \* Colored pencils (any type)
- 15. \* Black felt tip pen

You DON'T need ALL these materials on your first class. You can come with only graphite pencils, erasers and drawing/sketching paper. We'll discuss your further steps.
